NEW RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS:

Beginning the week of May 2, 2011, the Town
of Elkton will modify the current twice a week
trash collection to **once-a-week trash
collection** and **once-a-week recyclables
collection** in accordance with the Cecil
County recycling requirements.

In Patriots Glen, **trash will be collected on
Monday of every week** and single stream
recyclables will be collected every Thursday.
The first collection date for recyclables will be
Thursday, May 5th. A separate container is
required for recyclables. Please go to the
