The pool will open on 5/23. You must have an access card to use the pool. If you do not have access cards, please contact Aspen Management at 410-620-2598.

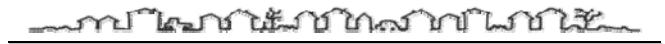
**NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PROGRAM**

**NOTE: CHANGE IN GRASS COLLECTION**

The town of Elkton is now collecting loose (not bagged) grass clippings placed inside plastic containers. Containers guidelines:

- 32 gallon Maximum Capacity
- Secure Lid
- Visibly marked with the word "GRASS" or "GREEN WASTE" (4-10" letters)
